## Mala schools rated second in Varanasi District

It is with great pride that we announce our second position among 396 schools in Varanasi District, and our commendable standing at 190th place in Uttar Pradesh State, out of 27,627 schools. The results come from our affiliation to the Uttar Pradesh Education Board.

Receiving recognition from external agencies is always gratifying, as it provides valuable insights into the impact of our efforts, particularly in the context of our work for underprivileged children.

The evaluation was based on six key parameters. Project Mala excelled in a number of aspects, notably we achieved the highest scores in areas such as exam results, facilities provided to children, infrastructure and the student/teacher ratio. It is noteworthy that our lower scores in the number of children and classrooms are circumstances beyond our control, given our charitable status and limited resources.

There were six parameters for scoring and Project Mala's scores are.
