## Enrolment 2024

Welcoming new children into our school every year is always an exciting and enriching experience. Each admission brings fresh faces and unique talents from diverse backgrounds.

Project Mala school enrolment is nothing less than any festival in the villages it serves. We make sure to create a warm and inclusive environment where every child is valued and supported as they start their educational journey with us. Our dedicated staff and existing students eagerly extend a helping hand to newcomers, ensuring a smooth transition and fostering friendships that often last a lifetime

As is customary each year, we received 3121 applications, with 2635 coming from external applicants seeking admission to our schools. This overwhelming response underscores the trust and confidence parents have in Project Mala. We are deeply grateful for the immense interest shown by so many families in entrusting their children's education to us. However, with a maximum capacity of 650 available places, we are faced with the challenge of not being able to accommodate all applicants. 283 children out of 486 were selected from Project Mala to continue their education with us and 379 out of 2635 external children were enrolled in various sections as tabulated below.
